**LOCAL RULES**

**1. OUT OF BOUNDS**

- a) Beyond any fence, footpath or hedges bounding the course.
- b) Any ball that finishes or crosses over the fenced footpath that runs through the golf course.

**c) Any part of the golf range.**

- d) Beyond the white posts dividing the 16th and 17th fairways while playing the 17th. Beyond the white posts dividing the 9th and 10th fairways while playing the 9th.
- e) Beyond the white posts to the right of the 1st hole and to the left of the 7th hole.

- f) Over the fence bounding the lake, in the flower bed behind the green and beyond the white posts surrounding the shoe cleaning area on the 18th hole.

**2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**

Water hazards are marked with yellow posts and lateral water hazards with red posts.

**3. STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)**

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

**4. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS/DRAIN COVERS (Rule 24-2)**

All fixed sprinkler heads and drain covers are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2.

**5. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES/ SHRUBS (Rule 24-2b(i))**

All trees and shrubs identified by being staked are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2b.

**6. ROADS, PATHS AND STEPS**

All roads, paths and steps are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2b.

**7. OVERHEAD POWER CABLES**

If a ball strikes any overhead power cable, the shot must be replayed, without penalty, from where the ball originally lay.

**8. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25-1)**

The range fence and strip of ground one club-length towards the 1st fairway is ground under repair and relief may be obtained under Rule 25-1.

**9. 1st HOLE**

The nets and upright poles to the left of the 1st fairway are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2b(i).

**10. BRIDGES**

All bridges are deemed to be immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under Rule 24-2b.

**PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:**

**Match Play - Loss of Hole;  
Stroke Play - Two Shots.**

Distance markers in the middle of the fairways indicate measurements to the centre of the green.

Yellow = 150 yards, Red = 100 yards

Pin Positions on Green

Red Flag = Front, Yellow Flag = Middle, White Flag = Back
